

2024-2025 STITE High School Scholarship

The South Texas Institute of Transportation Engineers (STITE) is pleased to announce its high school scholarship for senior high school students interested in a career in an engineering/transportation-related field.

STITE will award one (non-renewable) scholarship for one academic year in the amount up to \$2,500 to an outstanding high school senior during the 2024-2025 school year. In order to be considered for the scholarship, applicants must have all the following qualifications:

- 1. Be a senior in high school
- 2. Attend a high school within the STITE Section area and;
- 3. be actively enrolled as a high school senior studying to pursue a degree in science, technology, engineering, art or math.

- 1. One (1) signed application form (provided below),
- 2. One (1) High School transcript indicating a GPA of 3.0 or higher,
- 3. One (1) letter of recommendation by either a teacher, counselor or school principal
- 4. One (1) completed short answer section (you may answer in the sheet provided or in a separate word doc).
